Pursuant to the Series K Articles Supplementary, our board of directors may, without stockholder approval, permanently revoke this right to pay the redemption price (or a portion thereof) in shares of our common stock and pay the redemption price solely in cash.

Ashford Hospitality Trust, Inc., a publicly traded REIT, Series K redeemable preferred stock. By way of background, traditional traded preferred securities are similar to fixed-income investments with equity-like features mainly issued by large corporations, banks and insurance companies. These securities may be perpetual and callable, typically pay dividends instead of coupons, offer multiple rate structures, often have investment grade ratings, and are subordinated in the capital structure. The security has priority of receiving dividends over common stockholders.

In the event of the Company's liquidation and with respect to the payment of dividends and distributions, the Series K Redeemable Preferred Stock ranks senior to the Company's common stock and on par with the Company's other Preferred Stock, including the Series K Redeemable Preferred Stock, the 8.45% Series D Cumulative Preferred Stock, the 7.375% Series F Cumulative Preferred Stock, the 7.375% Series G Cumulative Preferred Stock, the 7.50% Series H Cumulative Preferred Stock, and the 7.50% Series I Cumulative Preferred Stock.

There is no public trading market for the Series K Redeemable Preferred stock.

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SUMMARY OF RISK FACTORS

An investment in our securities involves significant risks. Prior to making a decision about investing in our securities, and in consultation with your own financial, tax and legal advisors, you should carefully consider, among other matters, the following risk factors related to this offering, as well as the other risk factors incorporated by reference in this prospectus, from our most recent Annual Report on Form 10-K, subsequent Quarterly Reports on Form 10-Q and Current Reports on Form 8-K under the headings "Risk Factors" and "Management's Discussion and Analysis of Financial Condition and Results of Operations," as applicable, and other filings we may make from time to time with the SEC.

- There will initially be no public trading market for the Series K Preferred Stock as we do not intend to apply for listing on the NYSE until after the Termination Date, if at all, and even after listing, if achieved, a liquid secondary trading market may not develop and the features of the Series K Preferred Stock may not provide you with favorable liquidity options.
- If, after the Series K Preferred Stock becomes listed on the NYSE or another national securities exchange, the Preferred Stock is delisted, your ability to transfer or sell your shares of the Series K Preferred Stock may be limited, and the market value of the Series K Preferred Stock will likely be materially adversely affected.
- The Series K Preferred Stock is subordinated in right of payment to our existing and future debt, and your interests could be diluted by the issuance of additional preferred stock, including additional shares of Series K Preferred Stock, and by other transactions.
- The Change of Control conversion rights that commence upon a listing of the Series K Preferred Stock on a national securities exchange may not adequately compensate you, and the Change of Control conversion and redemption features of the Series K Preferred Stock may make it more difficult for a party to take over our company or discourage a party from taking over our company.
- Dividends on our preferred stock, including the Series K Preferred Stock, are discretionary. We cannot guarantee that we will be able to pay dividends in the future or what the actual dividends will be for any future period.
- The Series K Preferred Stock has not been rated.
- In the event you exercise your option to redeem Series K Preferred Stock, our ability to redeem such shares of Series K Preferred Stock may be subject to certain restrictions and limits.
- Shares of Series K Preferred Stock may be redeemed for shares of common stock, which rank junior to the Series K Preferred Stock with respect to dividends and upon liquidation, dissolution or winding up of our affairs.
- The Series K Preferred Stock will bear a risk of early redemption by us.
- The amount of your liquidation preference is fixed and you will have no right to receive any greater payment regardless of the circumstances.
- Upon the sale of any hotel properties, holders of Series K Preferred Stock do not have a priority over holders of our common stock regarding return of capital.
- We established the offering price and other terms for the Preferred Stock pursuant to discussions between us and our dealer manager; as a result, the actual value of your investment may be substantially less than what you pay.
- We intend to use the net proceeds from this offering to fund future investments and for other general corporate and working capital purposes, but this offering is not conditioned upon the closing of properties in our current pipeline and we will have broad discretion to determine alternative uses of proceeds.
- Our ability to pay dividends and redeem shares of Series K Preferred Stock may be limited by the requirements of Maryland law.
- Investors in the Series K Preferred Stock will not enjoy the protections afforded by registration of this offering under state securities laws.
- The dealer manager's relationship with us may cause a conflict of interest and may hinder the dealer manager's performance of its due diligence obligations.
- If we fail to pay dividends to holders of our preferred stock or otherwise lose our eligibility to file registration statements on Form S-3 with the SEC, it may impair our ability to raise capital in this offering.
- Your ownership of Series K Preferred Stock is subject to the ownership limits contained in our charter.
- Compliance with the SEC's Regulation Best Interest by participating broker-dealers may negatively impact our ability to raise capital in this offering, which could harm our ability to achieve our investment objectives.

There is no public market for the Series K Preferred Stock and we do not expect one to develop.
